Use of Analysis & Data Policy

1. Purpose of Soil Biology Analysis

All analyses conducted by Rewild Soils Lab are diagnostic snapshots in time. Results reflect the biology of the submitted sample only and are intended to guide learning, management decisions, and improvement over time. Analyses do not constitute certification, product endorsement, or a guarantee of performance.

2. Client Use of Reports & Results

Clients are welcome to share their reports publicly or privately, provided results are represented accurately and in context. Benchmark terms such as “low,” “in range,” or “high” are dependent on the plant succession stage selected at the time of analysis.

Reports may not be summarized or interpreted in a way that materially contradicts the written findings, nor presented as certification or endorsement by Rewild Soils, without written permission.

3. Use of Data by Rewild Soils Lab

By submitting samples for analysis, clients grant Rewild Soils Lab permission to store results in a secure internal database and to use anonymized, aggregated data for:

- annual benchmarking and trend analysis
- meta-analysis of microbial ranges by sample category (e.g. compost type)
- education, research communication, and professional presentations

All aggregated use excludes client names, brands, and identifying information and does not rank or compare named producers.

4. Attribution, Endorsement & Trademarks
